# They Tall QUILT



# **MATERIALS:**

[1] ATXSH Panel

[42] ATXSH Collectible Quilt Shop Blocks

1-1/2 yards Blender Navy

1-1/8 yards Flags

1-1/8 yards Butterflies

2-3/4 yards Stripe

3/4 yard Blender Blue for binding

7 yards Blender Navy or preferred fabric for backing

READ THROUGH ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE STARTING THIS PROJECT. FABRICS ARE SEWN RIGHT-SIDES TOGETHER USING A 1/4" SEAM ALLOWANCE THROUGHOUT. WOF = WIDTH OF FABRIC; LOF = LENGTH OF FABRIC; RST = RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER

## **CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:**

## **From ATXSH Panel Fabric:**

Trim [1] -42-1/2"W  $\times 35-1/2$ "H

# From ATXSH Collectible Quilt Shop Blocks:

Trim [42] - 4-1/2" squares

# From Blender, Navy Fabric:

Cut [12]  $- 1-1/2" \times WOF$  strips

Cut [2]  $- 3-1/2" \times WOF$  strips

Subcut [2] - 3-1/2"  $\times$  35-1/2" rectangles (A)

Cut [3]  $-3'' \times$  WOF strips; piece lengthwise Subcut [2]  $-3'' \times 48-1/2''$  rectangles **(B)** 

Cut [8]  $-2" \times$  WOF strips; piece into [4] pairs Subcut [2]  $-2" \times 72$ -1/2", for Border 1 sides Subcut [2]  $-2" \times 67$ -1/2", for Border 1 top and bottom

# From Flags Fabric:

Cut [6]  $-2" \times WOF$  strips

Cut [6]  $-4" \times WOF$  strips

#### From Butterflies Fabric:

Cut  $\lceil 6 \rceil - 2'' \times WOF$  strips

Cut [6]  $-4" \times WOF$  strips

# From Stripe Fabric:

Cut [4] identical —  $9'' \times \text{LOF}$  strips Subcut [2] —  $9'' \times 99''$ , for Border 2 sides Subcut [2] —  $9'' \times 90''$ , for Border 2 top and bottom

## From Blender, Blue Fabric:

Cut [10]  $-2-1/4" \times WOF$ , for binding

# **BLOCK ASSEMBLY:**

#### **Panel Block:**

- 1. Sew [2] Blender Blue  $3-1/2" \times 35-1/2"$  rectangles **(A)** to the sides of the ATXSH Panel.
- 2. Sew [2] Blender Blue  $3'' \times 48$ -1/2" rectangles **(B)** to the top and bottom of the panel. The Panel Block should measure 48-1/2" W  $\times$  40-1/2" H.





# **Collectible Quilt Squares Block:**


- Combine [1] Flag 2" × WOF strip, [1] —
  Blender Navy 1-1/2" × WOF strips and [1] —
  Butterflies 2" × WOF strips to make a strip
  set. Make [6] strip sets.
- 2. Cut strip sets into [84] 2-1/2" small strip unit segments.



- 3. Combine [1] Flag  $4'' \times WOF$  strip, [1] Blender Navy 1-1/2"  $\times WOF$  strips and [1] Butterflies  $4'' \times WOF$  strips to make a strip set. Make [6] strip sets.
- 4. Cut strip sets into [84] 2-1/2" large strip unit segments.



 Combine [1] — ATXSH Collectible Quilt 4-1/2" square, [2] — 2-1/2" small strip unit segments and [2] — 2-1/2" large strip unit segments to make the Collectible Quilt Square Block. NOTE: Make sure the writing is upright with the Flag Fabric in the upper left corner. Each Collectible Quilt Square Block should measure 8-1/2" square. Make [42].




# **QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY:**

Pay close attention to block placement and block rotation.

- 1. Combine [5] Collectible Quilt Square Blocks into a vertical column. Make [2].
- 2. Sew the vertical units to each side of the Panel Block.



- 3. Combine [8] Collectible Quilt Square Blocks in a row horizonally. Make [4].
- 4. Sew [2] horizontal units together vertically. Make [2].



5. Sew the horizontal units to the top and bottom of the quilt top assembly.



#### **BORDERS:**

#### **Border 1**

- 1. Using the Blender Navy Border 1  $2'' \times 72-1/2''$  strips, sew to both sides of the Quilt Top Center.
- 2. Then, sew on Border 1  $2'' \times 67-1/2''$  strips to the top and bottom of Quilt Top Center.

#### **Border 2**

Prior to adding Border 2, find a video online showing how to miter borders. There are many to choose from. Do not trim the length of the borders until after mitering. If you don't want to miter the corners, you can cut and measure them to fit.

- 1. Sew the Stripe  $9'' \times 99''$  Border 2 to both sides of the Quilt Top Center.
- 2. Then, add the Stripe  $9'' \times 90''$  Border 2 Top and Bottom and miter each corner. At this point the quilt top should measure  $84-1/2'' \times 92-1/2''$ .



# **FINISHING:**

- 1. Layer quilt top with batting and backing.
- 2. Baste and Quilt.
- 3. Bind with the binding strips.
- 4. Don't forget to put a label on your quilt.
- 5. Enjoy!
